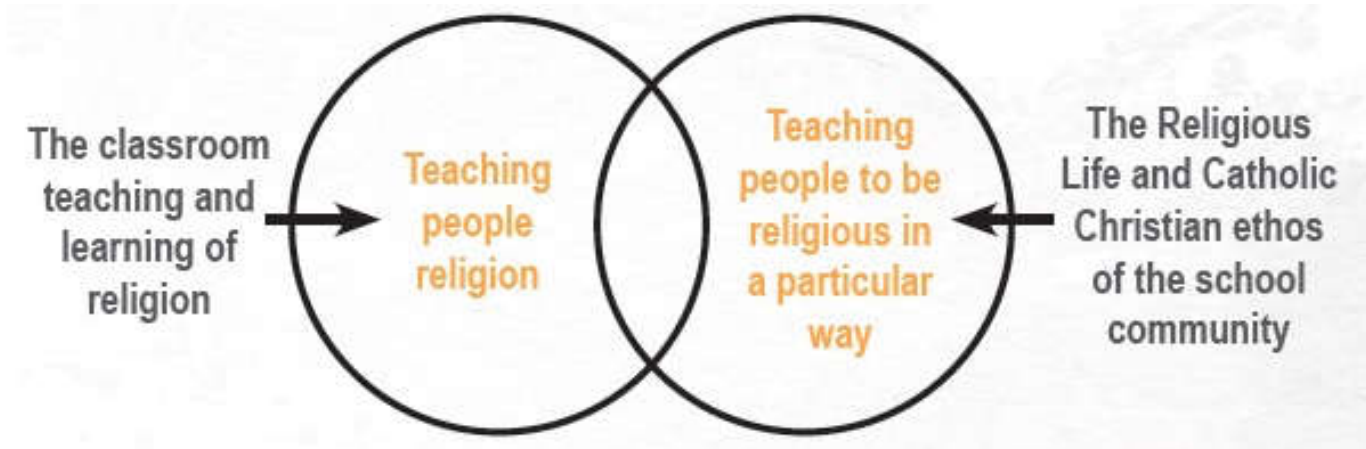


Figure 6: Model for Religious Education – teaching Religion and teaching to be Religious
